

Cape Girardeau County Commission Minutes

CAPE GIRARDEAU COUNTY COMMISSION, MINUTES OF MONDAY, MARCH 15, 2010, ELEVENTH DAY OF FEBRUARY TERM (EVENING MEETING)

Commission met pursuant to adjournment. Present were Presiding Commissioner Gerald Jones; First District Commissioner Paul Koeper; Second District Commissioner Jay Purcell; and Deputy Clerk of the Commission Donna Oldham.

Prior Minutes

Presiding Commissioner Gerald Jones asked if there were any corrections to the minutes. There being none, the minutes were approved as presented.

Local Emergency Planning Committee Appointment

A motion was made by Commissioner Koeper and seconded by Commissioner Purcell to approve appointment of Jamie Koehler, as a member of the community group, on the Local Emergency Planning Committee. Motion passed unanimously (Jones-Aye, Koeper-Aye, Purcell-Aye). Letters filed.

Public Hearing Regarding Setting of Speed Limits

Public Hearing held regarding proposed Ordinance 10-O1 to set speed limit of 35 mph on County Road 205 and 25 mph on Singing Hills Drive. Ordinance was available for review by the public. Several citizens spoke in favor of the ordinance (Rock Wilferth, Larry Frankum, Charles Brawley, Jeff Timmerman and Scott Bechtold). There were no citizens present that were not in favor of the ordinance. This was the first of three public hearings. Ordinance will be signed after public hearing is held on March 18th.

Purchase Orders Approved

A motion was made by Commissioner Koeper and seconded by Commissioner Purcell to approve purchase orders, as presented by the County Auditor's Office. Motion passed unanimously (Jones-Aye, Koeper-Aye, Purcell-Aye).

Agreement With Little River Drainage District

Sam Hunter, President, and Larry Dowdy, Executive Secretary, of The Little River Drainage District, appeared before the County Commission at which time Agreement was executed between The Little River Drainage District and Cape Girardeau County for clearing of banks on portion of Old Whitewater Channel, with this agreement contingent upon "Little River" obtaining the commitment of Federal Funding for the necessary channel work. The County then agrees to pay Little River for said work and services the sum of \$144,000 to be paid in three equal installments of \$48,000 each. Agreement filed.
