CAPE GIRARDEAU COUNTY COMMISSION, MINUTES OF THURSDAY, MARCH 18, 2010, TWELFTH DAY OF FEBRUARY TERM

Commission met pursuant to adjournment. Present were Presiding Commissioner Gerald Jones; First District Commissioner Paul Koeper; Second District Commissioner Jay Purcell; and Deputy Clerk of the Commission Donna Oldham.

Purchase Orders Approved

A motion was made by Commissioner Koeper and seconded by Commissioner Purcell to approve purchase orders, as presented by the Auditor's Office. Motion passed unanimously (Jones-Aye, Koeper-Aye, Purcell-Aye).

Southeast Missouri Stone

Received copy of public notification letter regarding permit expansion from Southeast Missouri Stone Company. Letter filed.

North County Park Maintenance

Bruce Watkins, Park Superintendent, appeared before the County Commission to request to have rip-rap placed around lake edges at the North County Park upper lake to control shore and levee erosion. A motion was made by Commissioner Purcell and seconded by Commissioner Koeper to approve project, as weather and County Highway Department work schedules permit, in the total estimated amount of \$26,880. (Estimated cost of stone - \$10,880, and estimated labor and equipment - \$16,000). Motion passed unanimously (Jones-Aye, Koeper-Aye, Purcell-Aye). Letter filed.

Public Hearing Regarding Setting of Speed Limits

Public Hearing held regarding proposed Ordinance 10-O1 to set speed limit of 35 mph on County Road 205 and 25 mph on Singing Hills Drive. Ordinance was available for review by the public. Several citizens spoke in favor of the ordinance (Rock Wilferth, Charles Brawley, and Jeff Zimmerman). There were no citizens present that were not in favor of the ordinance. This was the last of three public hearings. Ordinance will now be presented for approval.

Ordinance 10-O1 To Set Speed Limits

Ordinance 10-O1 was presented for signing. A motion was then made by Commissioner Koeper and seconded by Commissioner Purcell to adopt Ordinance 10-O1, whereas the Cape Girardeau County Commission does hereby order the speed limit be set at 35 mph on County Road 205 and speed limit be set at 25 mph on Singing Hills Drive. Motion passed unanimously (Jones-Aye, Koeper-Aye, Purcell-Aye). Ordinance, public hearing notice and minutes from public hearings filed.

Adjourn

Presiding Commissioner Gerald Jones asked if there was any further business to come before the Commission. There being none, the Commission adjourned.
