QUESTION

For the purpose of providing revenues for the operation of the Cape Girardeau Municipal Fire Department, shall the City of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, impose a sales tax of one-quarter of one percent (1/4 of 1%)?

The approval of the proposition will authorize the levy and collection of a one-quarter of one percent (1/4 of 1%) sales tax in addition to the other sales taxes provided for by law on all retail sales made in the City that are subject to taxation.

QUESTION

For the purpose of providing funds for the general revenue of the City, shall the City of Cape Girardeau, Missouri impose a local use tax at the same rate as the total local sales tax rate, currently two percent (2.00%), provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action? A use tax return shall not be required to be filed by persons whose purchases from out of state vendors do not in total exceed two thousand dollars in any calendar year.

QUESTION

Shall the City of Cape Girardeau establish a stormwater management utility charge that will be used to provide stormwater management services within the City's corporate limits and provide for flood control and for the management, planning, protection, control, regulation, use and enhancement of stormwater systems and facilities?

The maximum charges for this stormwater management utility shall be authorized as follows:

Single Family Residential

- 1.Zero to 1200 square feet of building footprint: Up to \$1.75 per month.
- 2.1201 to 2250 square feet of building footprint: Up to \$3.50 per month.
- 3.Greater than 2250 square feet of building footprint: Up to \$5.25 per month.

All Other Property

Up to \$0.075 per month per one hundred (100) square feet of impervious surface.

These charges shall be limited to an annual increase of no more than five percent (5%) per year as determined by the Cape Girardeau City Council.
