

OFFICIAL VOTE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

March 4th, 1941.

I, W. C. Kaempfer, City Clerk of the City of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, hereby certify that this is a true and correct statement of the vote polled at the Special Election held in the City of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, Tuesday, March 4th, 1941.

PROPOSITION.

The City of Cape Girardeau shall, through the proper officials, offer to convey, and convey if said offer be accepted, a portion of what is commonly known as Courthouse Park owned by said City, to the United States of America for the purpose of constructing thereon a Post Office and Federal Court building to cost approximately \$430,000.00, and shall receive in exchange and trade therefor the property known as the present Post Office and Federal Court site in said City, the building thereon to be used for City purposes and as a Common Pleas Courthouse. Such exchange and trade shall be done in accordance with Commission Form Ordinance No. 905, passed and approved on the 11th day of February, 1941, which ordinance specifically describes the parcels of land to be exchanged and to which reference is made for a more specific description.
