A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF CAPE GIRARDEAU, MISSOURI, ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 1983, ON THE QUESTION WHETHER TO LEVY A LICENSE TAX ON HOTELS AND MOTELS IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THREE PER CENT OF GROSS RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM TRANSIENT GUESTS FOR SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS AND ON RESTAURANTS IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ONE PER CENT OF GROSS RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM THE RATAIL SALE OF FOOD

7) BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPE GIRARDEAU, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby found and declared that the vote at the Special Election held in the City of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, on Tuesday, November 8, 1983, on the question whether to levy a license tax on hotels and motels in an amount equal to three per cent of gross receipts derived from transient guests for sleeping accommodations and on restaurants in an amount equal to one per cent of gross receipts derived from the retail sale of food for the purpose of retiring the multi-use center bonds and to promote conventions, tourism and economic development was as follows:

Yes: 1,220 Votes
No: 767 Votes

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and declared that more than a simple majority of the qualified voters of the City voting on said question at said Special Election voted in favor of levying the tax and that the governing body of the City of Cape Girardeau is therefore vested with full power and authority to proceed with the levying of the proposed license tax on hotels, motels and restaurants.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and declared that since a majority of the qualified voters of the City voting in the November 8, 1983 Special Election approved the levy of the license tax set forth in Ordinance No. 101, the Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 1984.

SECTION 4. That is further found and declared that Notice of the November 8, 1983 Special Election was duly given by publication in the manner provided by law and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity with the Constitution and Laws of the State of Missouri.
