PROPOSITION I

Shall the Board of Education of the Reorganized School District R-II of Cape Girardeau County, Missouri be authorized to increase the operating tax levy of the District by \$0.47 per \$100 of assessed valuation of real and personal property for the purpose of paying general operating expenses of the District, including attracting and retaining quality teachers and staff, protecting programs and class sizes, and continuing transportation services?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to be \$3.9098 per \$100 of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

PROPOSITION N

Shall the Board of Education of the Reorganized School District R-II of Cape Girardeau County, Missouri borrow money in the amount of \$60,000,000 for the purposes of (a) acquiring, purchasing, renovating, constructing, furnishing and equipping school sites, buildings and related facilities, including but not limited to (1) purchasing, constructing, or remodeling classroom space at the high school, (2) renovations to increase security, (3) classroom and gymnasium additions at North Elementary, (4) repairing and replacing roofs, and (5) a performing arts center, and (b) refinancing outstanding leasehold obligations, and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.44 per \$100 of assessed valuation of real and personal property?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is estimated to increase from \$0.3600 to \$0.8000 per \$100 assessed valuation of real and personal property.

The authorization of the Bonds in Proposition N will authorize the levy and collection of an annual tax in addition to the other taxes provided for by law on all taxable tangible property in the District sufficient to pay the interest and principal of the Bonds as they become due.
